

SNOW PARKING ORDINANCE #10

Whereas, the Board of Township Trustees, pursuant to the authority and mandates of Chapter 139 and 121, Illinois Statutes, believe that the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Roscoe Township would be served by a snow parking ordinance;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees and Supervisor of Roscoe Township, Winnebago County, Illinois, as follows:

No person shall park any motor vehicle on any Roscoe Township public roadway after ~~two~~^{1 1/2} or more inches of snow has fallen until such time as the snow has been plowed to the side of the street, or until the passage of 48 hours, whichever shall first occur.


Any person who shall violate this Ordinance impliedly consents to the removal of the said vehicle, by authorized representatives of Roscoe Township, at the expense of the owner thereof.

The provisions and sections of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable, and the invalidity of any portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder.

This Ordinance shall become effective 10 days after publication.
