TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
ROSCOE TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT
ORDINANCE 2025-1R

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for Roscoe Township Road District, Winnebago County, Illinois, for the tax year 2025, collectable in 2026.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Roscoe Township, Winnebago County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of the Roscoe Township Road District on December 18, 2025, does hereby determine and declare that the sum of Eight Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Seventy-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$884,074.00) is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Roscoe Township Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the Roscoe Township Road District, as required by statute, or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as

ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND
PERMANENT ROAD (HARD ROAD) FUND
BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION W/COUNTY (SPECIAL BRIDGE) FUND

For the year 2025

SECTION 2: That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

GENERAL ROAD FUND

Total General Road Fund \$ 89,330.00

PERMANENT ROAD (HARD ROAD) FUND

Total Permanent Road Fund \$786,754.00

GENERAL ASSISTANCE FUND

Total Bridge Construction Fund \$ 7,990.00

TOTAL TAX LEVY SUMMARY

General Road Tax \$ 89,330.00
Permanent Road Tax \$786,754.00
Bridge Construction Tax \$ 7,990.00
TOTAL TAXES LEVIED: \$884,074.00

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Amount to be levied was determined by the Highway Commissioner of the Roscoe Township Road District.

SECTION 3: That the Township Clerk shall make and file with the County Clerk of said County of Winnebago on or before the last Tuesday of December, a duly certified copy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: That the Roscoe Township Board of Trustees does hereby certify that the amount levied herein is necessary to be raised by taxation for road purposes for the Roscoe Township Road District.

SECTION 5: That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.

ADOPTED this 18TH day of December 2025 pursuant to a roll call vote by the Board of Trustees of Roscoe Township, Winnebago County, Illinois.

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

TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE
LOPI GUMMOW

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Roscoe Township and the Roscoe Township Road District, Winnebago County, Illinois, and as such presiding officer, I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-90 of the Truth in Taxation Act.

Check one of the following:

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the Truth in Taxation Act.
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.
- 3) The proposed aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a hearing was not held. The adopted tax levy exceeded 5% of the prior year's extension and a notice was published within 15 days of its adoption in accordance with the Truth in Taxation Act.
- 4) The adopted levy exceed the amount stated in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the Truth in Taxation Act.
